## **Helpful Information/Ordinances**

Our City Hall is available to rent for events (such as family dinners) for \$45.00. The reservation calendar is kept at the Kanza Co-op Farm Store

Trash is picked up early each Friday morning. We encourage recycling. It is good for our environment, and since the landfill charges us by weight, recycling saves the City of Iuka money. While some residents burn trash, we need to be aware of County burn bans, and KDHE indicates that a statewide ban on trash burning is in the works.

Dogs are to be kept on the owner's property or on a leash. Non-domestic animals (such as cows, horses, sheep, goats, etc) are not allowed to be kept within the City limits.

Grass must be kept at a height no taller than 12 inches. A notice will be sent giving the property owner 10 days to comply. After that time the city will mow, and bill the owner \$75.00.

Untagged vehicles must be moved out of sight or disposed of.
